What is the TEACH Grant Program?

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program provides grants of up to \$4,000 per year to students who agree to teach for four years at an elementary school, secondary school, or educational service agency that serves students from low-income families. You also will need to meet other requirements, which are outlined in the TEACH Grant Program Guidebook.
